We pray for John's soul and for his family.

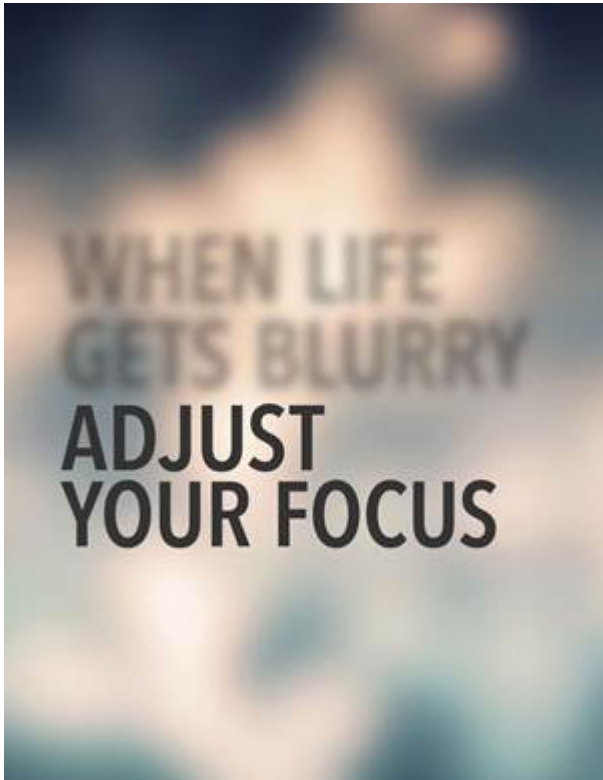
What are you thankful for today?
