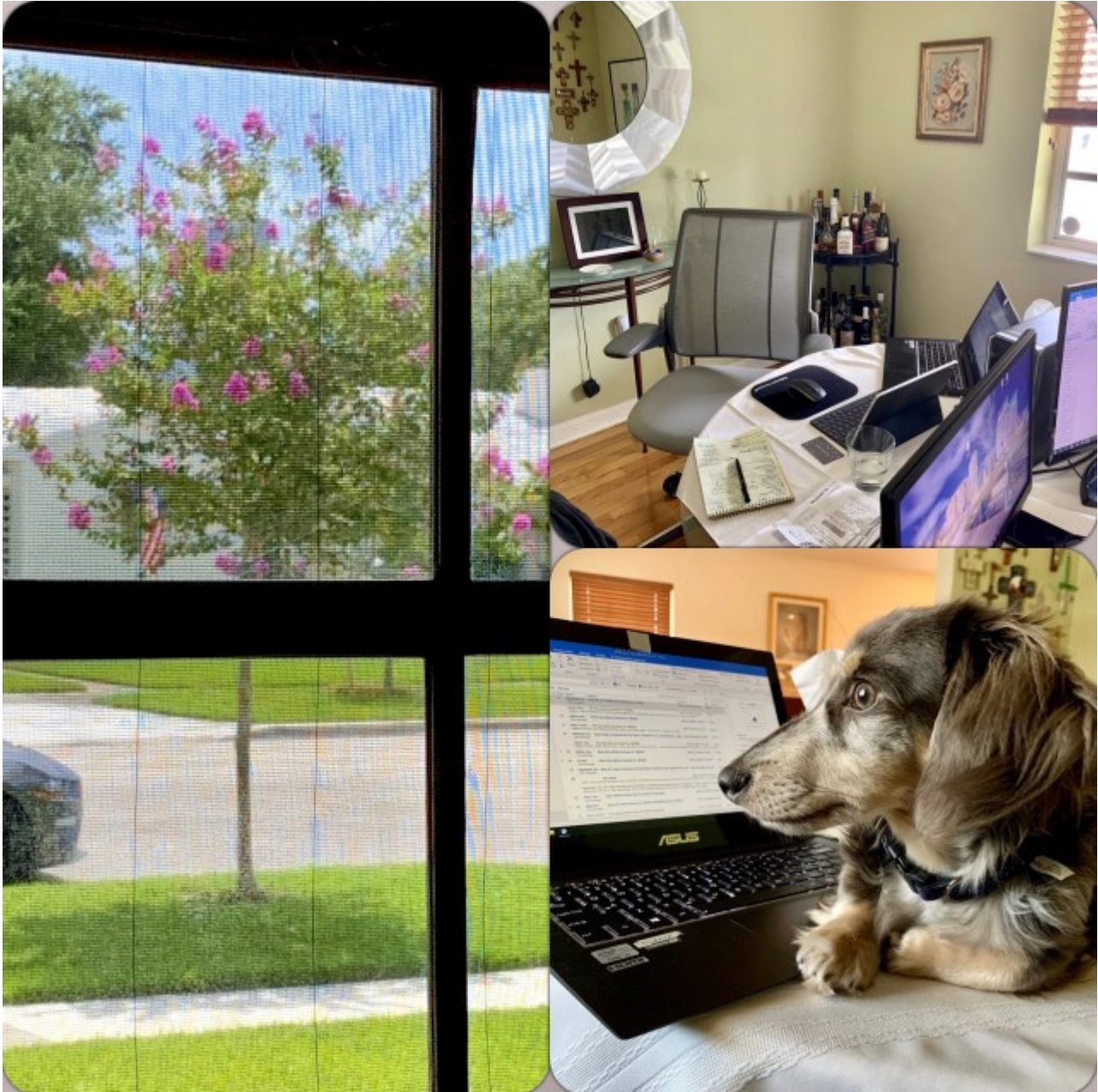




For interim spots.
