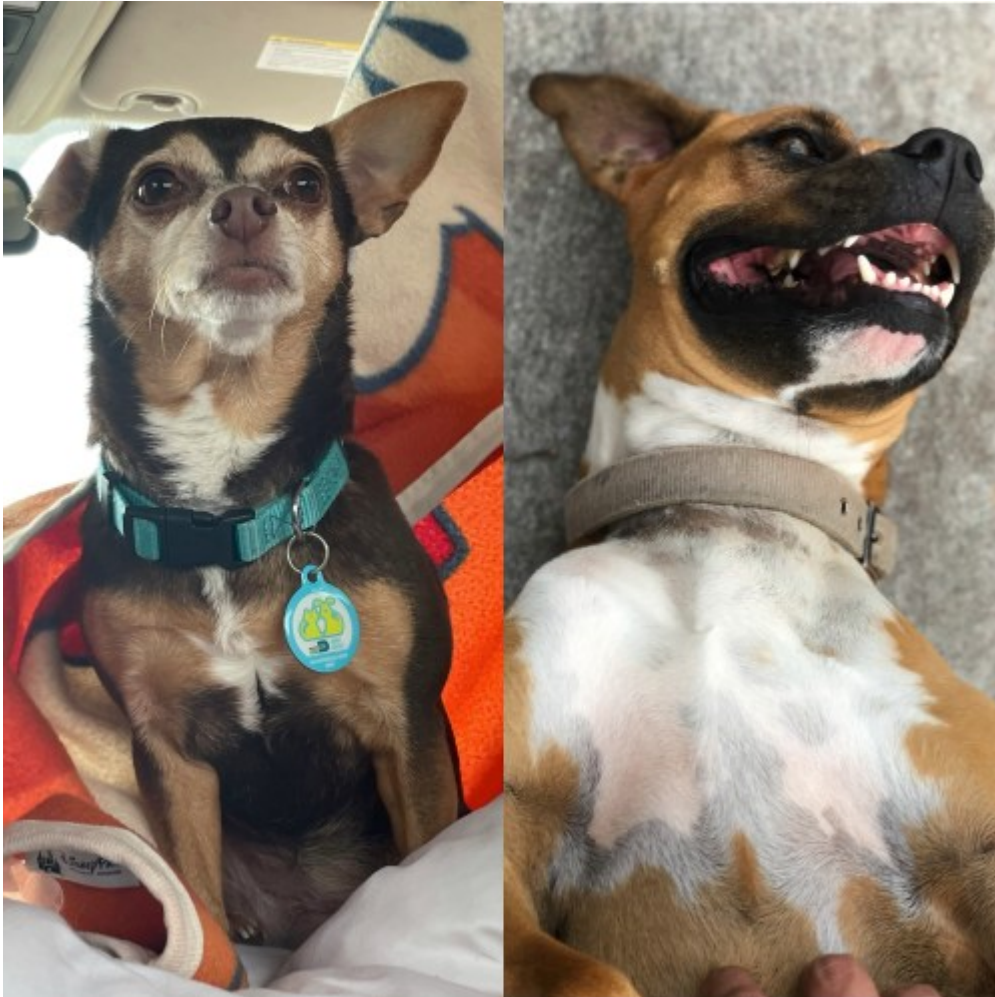


And this of course is **BENI HEINZ**. He was a surprise, courtesy of Lauren. Lucky for us, he decided to keep us. ?

Nancy: I'm thankful for all the unconditional love and happiness I receive from my furry children Harley, Maggie and Ely.



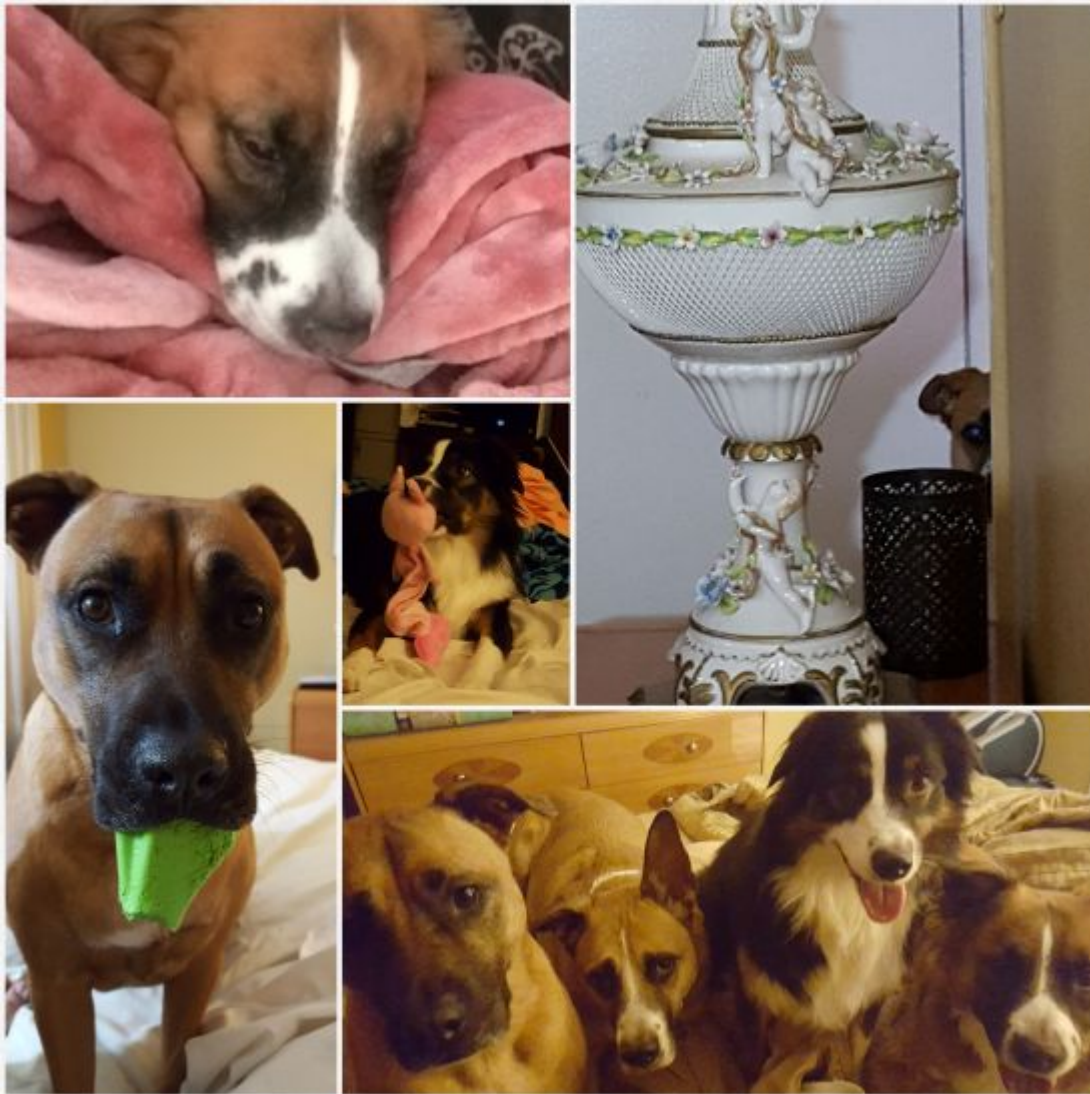
CASTLE. This dude hangs out with the Garcia clan.

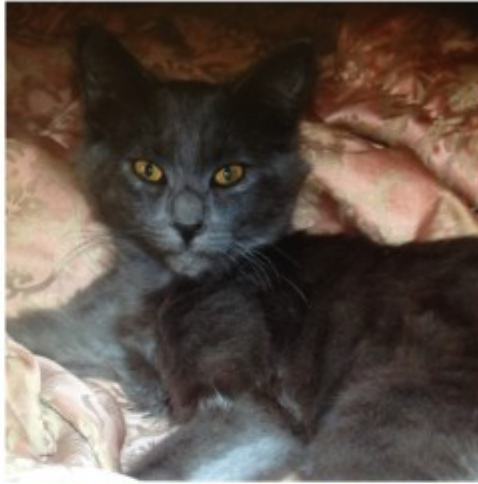
